
The school, situated in a locality mostly inhabited by people of lower income group, will strive for the purpose of making education available to all children irrespective of class, creed and religion. The school will be affiliated to the Central Board for Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.), Delhi.

In the MOU signed between Bruhat Bangalore Mahanagar Palike and Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan for running a school with CBSE syllabus in Srirampuram, the school would cater to the children in this area inhabited predominantly by economically weaker sections and also linguistic minorities. This initiative will help the children get into the mainstream of the society.



Under the arrangement BBMP will construct the school and Bhavan would provide facilities for imparting quality education to the children. The School will have 22 classrooms supported by a library, Computer Lab, Physics, Chemistry & Biology Labs and a huge play ground.

The total built up area will be 31,933 Sq. Ft. The School will also conduct Kalabharati classes in classical & light music (both vocal & instrumental), Drawing & Painting. Classes in yoga and meditation are also being held.
